6 stands Tarrantine Phalangites, A5/D2, B Grade, Poor Morale, in 1 unit

6 stands Mercenary Javelinmen, A2/D2/S, A Grade, Average Morale, in 2 or 3 units

30 infantry stands representing 28,000 men

5 stands Missile Troops, A0/D1/S/L, B Grade, Average Morale in 1 or 2 units representing 2500 light infantry

2 stands Agema, Shock Cavalry, A3/D1, A Grade, Exceptional Morale, 1 unit

2 stands Thessalians, Heavy Cavalry, A2/D1/S, A Grade, High Morale, in 1 unit

3 stands Tarrantines, Light Cavalry, A1/D0/S, B Grade, Average Morale, in 1 unit

7 stands representing 3000 cavalry

2 Elephants, A4/D3 representing 20 elephants
